Movie at the Pool Guidelines!

- Swim noodles & life jackets permitted.
- Must be toilet trained to be in pool.
- Kiddie pool closed. Hot tub closed (due to Covid limits)
- No swimming, splashing, going underwater, etc.
- Sitting around pool on chairs is welcome
- Under 12 yrs must have a parent/guardian on deck or in pool with them.
- **Water bottles only.**

Safety Matters at Fish Lake Beach

Surge protectors are recommended for appliances & electronics.

Overnight Campers: We ask that you comply with the rules that were part of the registration process.

Seasonal Campers: Please refer to the 2021 Handbook for information, guidelines and rules that were part of the seasonal licensing.

Gate Info

The interior entry gate is kept closed for security purposes. The entry gate opens with access cards. Seasonal campers have plastic access cards, overnight campers use paper. No card is needed to exit. Both gates are programmed to allow one car to enter or exit at a time.

Damage to gate equipment is subject to a \$700 fine. The gatehouse area is video monitored 24x7.

Vehicle Passes

2021 vehicle stickers (passes) must be on your car or you'll be charged admission at \$6 per person.

Golf Cart Passes

Golf cart permit passes must be adhered to your golf cart by June 1st. If seen without a permit, there is a verbal warning. Second violation is a \$50 fine. Remember to review the rules to golf cart permit rules. The licensee must be driving or a passenger. Do not allow children without a drivers license drive the cart!! Please, watch your speed!!

Firewood— You can buy pre-packaged firewood at the gatehouse for \$7/each. Split logs of firewood can be ordered by calling 847-546-2228 Friday or Saturday for delivery to your site between 4-6pm on that same day. Split logs are \$12 for 15 logs.

Extreme Heat Warning

We will be full this weekend and, in the past, have experienced issues with ComEd not bringing in adequate electricity during heat waves.

If the consumption of electricity in the surrounding communities is excessive, everyone, including Fish Lake, will receive less power.

To help avoid outages we suggest the following:

Reduce your overall electric consumption during this, or any heat wave. Shut off everything possible.

Your air conditioning will work at its most efficient state if the outside of the system is clean and has been serviced.

Surge protectors will shut your unit down if not enough electric is available or if the voltage changes 2-3 volts when other trailers AC starts up. Some surge protectors are too sensitive and will constantly shut down your elec. We have a brand we recommend. See YC

If a FLB fuse blows and there is an outage in your area, there are numerous reasons that cause this (including an air conditioner that needs servicing), but the solution is always the same: **we replace the fuse and the campers in that section must reduce their electric consumption. If they do not, outages will continue to happen.**

Please use only one air conditioner. In this heat our grid will not support the use of multiple air conditioners in one trailer.

Air conditioners

FOR YOUR **AIR CONDITIONER(S)** TO RUN EFFICIENTLY, COOL YOUR TRAILERS, AND NOT CAUSE ELECTRICAL SURGES THEY MUST BE CLEANED AND MAINTAINED. YOU CAN DO IT YOURSELF.

Clean your air conditioners for best performance !

- If cottonwood or dust is on outside panels, turn off your air, and wash panels from top to bottom using a spray nozzle & water or just vacuum.
- If panels are really dirty, please maintain and have a professional clean with chemicals.

Trash Talk....

NEW REQUEST- If the dumpster nearest to you is full, please use another dumpster. Many of them are half full, others are spilling over with rubbish by Saturday. Our pick ups are on Mondays so the dumpsters become unsightly. This past week our waste removal services let us know that two dumpsters were so blocked by extra bags of trash and in one case, a parked car, that the dumpsters could not be emptied.

As part of our effort to beautify the park we need your help with the use of our recycling and trash containers.

- We will pick up **bagged** yard waste if you leave it at the edge of your driveway.
- Please do not put yard waste in any container: if you do, our service provider will NOT empty that container!
- Please put recycling items in recycling containers and trash in trash containers.
- Please do not leave large objects (tv's, sofas, siding, appliances, mattresses, etc) outside of the trash containers,. If you have a large object call us so we can pick it up and dispose of it. A \$50+ fee applies.
- **Please collapse cardboard boxes** before putting them in the recycling container.

We get frequent pick ups to serve our needs but without your help the containers overflow quickly and it looks ugly and untidy. Thank you :)

Reminder: Please do not flush these in your toilet--- disinfecting wipes, baby wipes, personal hygiene wipes, cleaning wipes or wipes of any kind, including wipes labeled 'flushable'.
