#### **Gate Info**

The interior entry gate is kept closed for security purposes. It opens with access cards. Seasonal campers have plastic access cards, overnight campers use paper cards. No card is needed to exit. Both gates are programmed to allow one car to enter or exit at a time. Damage to gate equipment is subject to a \$700 fine. The gate area is video monitored 24x7.

#### Seasonal Campers: Vehicle Passes

2020 vehicle stickers (passes) must be on your windshield or the gate will charge daily admission at \$6 per person. Remove old stickers/passes.

# Our BEACH is open for campers to swim 10a-7p daily

- The beach will be open indefinitely this year.
- Please maintain a 6' distance from others not in your family in the water and on the beach itself.
- All other beach rules still apply.
- No swimming alone. Swim at

your own risk.

Campers must watch their own children while o the beach and swimming, regardless of whether a lifeguard is on duty or not.

#### Our POOL, HOT TUB, KIDDIE POOL is for campers only, no guests.

Update 8/28/2020– Pool will be closing by 7:00pm. Some time slots many not be 60 or 90 minutes.

- No sign up required Monday thru Friday until Friday 3P since that is the start of the weekend for overnight camping. No guard on duty. Please be respectful of 50 person limit. Bring your own sanitizer or use pool water to sanitize chair. Pool monitored with cameras.
- Sign up Friday starting at 3pm, Saturday and Sunday sign up will be required also. The link will be posted on those days at 8:30am.
- Friday 3p (3-4p, 4:30-5:30p, 6-7:00p), most Saturday, & most Sunday timeslots are 60 minutes.
- The pool will close daily at 7:00pm except for ADULT SWIM-see below.
- ADULT SWIM: Mon-Fri 9a-10:30a and Sunday –Thurs 8-10p. No signup needed
- All timeslots have a 50 persons Maximum in the pool deck enclosure.
- 50 chairs on the deck are 6' apart. Do not move.
- Maximum <u>7 persons in hot tub</u>. Limit use to 20 minutes to allow others a turn.
- Maximum 11 persons in kiddie pool. Limit use to 20 minutes to allow others a turn.
- ONLY sign up for ONE, timeslot a day. If you sign up for more than one timeslot, additional slots will be deleted.
- A 30 minute break between timeslots will be used to sanitize.
- Arrive within15 min of the start of your timeslot or it will go to walk-ins.
- The POOL, HOT TUB, KIDDY POOL are for campers only, no guests.
- Maintain safe distancing as you wait to enter.
- Face masks are permitted in the pool or on deck.
- All other posted pool rules apply.

#### For Your Convenience

Guest admission is allowed for seasonal campers: 1 car per site, per day. Use guest passes or pay \$6 per person. Guests must arrive before 9p unless pre-arranged with the management or gate attendant or guests will not be admitted. Overnight campers may not have guests.

**Boats:** Rowboat rental \$15/day. Paddleboard, pedal boat & kayak rental \$10 per hour, \$15 per hour for tandem kayak or canoes. Life jacket rental included. Boats must be off the lake by 6p. BOAT AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Fishing licenses required 15 y/o+. Sold in store. Cash.

Concessions food service until 6:30p, ice cream service until 7p. Concessions menu: pizza, chicken nuggets, mini corn dogs, cheesy fries, mozzarella sticks, & nachos.

**Deliveries:** Campers that order goods or services must meet the vendor at the interior gate for deliveries. This includes pizza/fast food or grocery deliveries. Doing so will prevent unauthorized access to the park or confusion for vendors.

**Campers mail:** Do not use the Fish Lake Beach address for mail or packages.

#### **Have a Safer Ride!**

Bike riders share our roads with everyone walking or driving. It is important that ALL RIDERS comply with these safety rules. Please talk with your kids! 1. Stop & look both ways before crossing or approaching an intersection. 2. Control your speedbe able to come to a complete stop easily. 3. Do not ride down hills without stopping.

#### Boat Safety

We love watching all the campers enjoying our lake with their private boats! Please remember that safety is our first priority and anyone boating on our lake must be wearing a coast guard approved life jacket. This applies to all ages and all types of boating!

#### Gate house Safety Reminder

Please remember to stop at the gate house even if the gate house attendant opens the gate for you.

Please look for other cars and campers at the intersection.

Reminder when entering and exiting Fish Lake at the gate house, the gates allow only 1 car at a time.

Firewood– Split logs of firewood or bundles can be ordered by calling 847-546-2228 (between 3p-6) on Friday or Saturday for delivery to your site between 4-6:30pm on that same day. Split logs are \$12 for 15 logs & bundles are \$7 each. You can buy prepackaged firewood at the gatehouse at any time.

Remind everyone who uses your toilet.....NEVER FLUSH WIPES OF ANY KIND and only use RV toilet paper.

Keep a trash can in your bathroom for baby wipes, facial wipes, flushable wipes\*, sanitary products and diapers.

\*Flushable wipes are not biodegradable-they do not break down.

Empty your tank regularly. Fill your tank with water prior to emptying. Treat your tank with additives, such as *AquaKem*, to help decompose waste and facilitate the emptying of your tank.
