Camper Rules and Policies at Fish Lake Beach

Overnight, Rental and Monthly Campers MUST comply with the rules signed at check in. A copy can be obtained at the store.

Seasonal Campers MUST comply with the rules in the 2023 Handbook Additional copies can be obtained at the store. Golf Cart Permit owners must comply with those rules or risk losing their permit. Do not allow anyone without a drivers license drive the cart!! Drive slowly, watch for others.

Trash Talk

We need your help! If you go to use a dumpster and it is full, **please use another dumpster.** There are many throughout the park on the main roads. Piling garbage on top of a full dumpster makes it impossible to close, which invites animals and allows odor to drift to the nearby trailers. GROSS!

Separately-large item pick up and disposal must be pre-paid at the office. Once paid, we will schedule pick-up from your site. Lastly, **2 recycling dumpsters** are by the pavilion near the bathroom-PLEASE BREAK DOWN BOXES AND DO NOT MIX TRASH WITH RECYCLABLES.

Tank & Toilet Talk

NEVER flush these in your toilet---disinfecting wipes, baby wipes, personal hygiene wipes, cleaning wipes or wipes of any kind, including wipes labeled 'flushable'. They damage our pumps which results in expensive repair PLUS sewer / water outages to multiple sections while we replace the pumps.

Gate Info

The interior entry gate opens with access cards. No card is needed to exit. Both gates are programmed to allow one car to enter or exit at a time. Damage to gate equipment is subject to a \$700 fine. The gate-house area is video monitored 24x7.

Vehicle Passes

2023 vehicle stickers must be on your windshield or your admission will be by appointment only. We are no longer allowing unregistered seasonals to simply pay \$6 admission without being paid in full and registered completely.

Electric Tips

We highly recommend the use of surge protectors in your trailer.

With your spring clean up, don't forget to get your air conditioner serviced! For it to work effectively when it gets warm, the coils must be cleaned.

Important to know...

- Do NOT put flushable wipes, feminine hygiene products or diapers in your toilets or any toilet on the property. It will cause sewage to back up & flood.
- The parking in front of the pool is now clearly marked for Handicap and golf cart (with handicap person) only. No vehicles may be parked there unless campers are in the pool and meet HC requirements. This is not an open extra parking area.

For Your Information

Guest Admission for Overnight, Monthly and Rental Campers: Guests must pay admission, \$6 per person (\$10 per person on holiday weekends). Guests must leave by 10p. Guest must park at the lake parking area if there are already 2 cars at your site.

Guests of Seasonal Campers: Guests must pay admission, \$6 per person. Guests must leave by 10p

Deliveries: Campers that order goods or services must meet the vendor at the interior gate. This includes pizza/fast food or grocery deliveries. This will prevent unauthorized access to the park or confusion for vendors.

Fishing: Fish from the shore or piers. Please not in the swimming area. Illinois Fishing license required for those 16+. Catch and Release until June 15th.

Seasonal and Monthly campers may not use the Fish Lake Beach address for mail or packages. Consider using **My Mailbox, Fox Lake.**
