### Camper Rules and Policies at Fish Lake Beach

**Overnight, Rental and Monthly Campers MUST** comply with the rules signed at check in. A copy can be obtained at the store.

**Seasonal Campers MUST comply with the rules** in the 2023 Handbook Additional copies can be obtained at the store. Golf Cart Permit owners must comply with those rules or risk losing their permit. Do not allow anyone without a drivers license drive the cart!! Drive slowly, watch for others.

### <u>Trash Talk</u>

We need your help! If you go to use a dumpster and it is full, <u>please use</u> <u>another dumpster</u>. There are many throughout the park on the main roads. Piling garbage on top of a full dumpster makes it impossible to close, which invites animals and allows odor to drift to the nearby trailers. GROSS!

Separately-large item pick up and disposal must be pre-paid at the office. Once paid, we will schedule pick-up from your site.

#### Tank & Toilet Talk

NEVER flush these in your toilet---disinfecting wipes, baby wipes, personal hygiene wipes, cleaning wipes or wipes of any kind, including wipes labeled 'flushable'. They damage our pumps which results in expensive repair PLUS sewer / water outages to multiple sections while we replace the pumps.

#### Gate Info

The interior entry gate opens with access cards. No card is needed to exit. Both gates are programmed to allow one car to enter or exit at a time. Damage to gate equipment is subject to a \$700 fine. The gate-house area is video monitored 24x7.

#### Vehicle Passes

2023 vehicle stickers must be on your windshield or your admission will be by appointment only. We are no longer allowing unregistered seasonals to simply pay \$6 admission without being paid in full and registered completely.

We highly recommend the use of surge protectors in your trailer. For you're a/c to work efficiently clean the coils and maintain the unit. When the temperatures are high please reduce your electric consumption and use only one a/c unit to help reduce the possibility of power outages in the park. Guest Admission for Overnight, Monthly and Rental Campers: Admission, \$6 per person (<u>\$10 per person on holiday week-ends</u>). Guests must leave by 10p.

**Guests of Seasonal Campers**: Admission, \$6 per person. Guests must leave by 10p

All Guest must park at the lake parking area if there are already 2 cars at your site or your site cannot accommodate your guests' vehicles.

**Deliveries:** Campers that order goods or services must meet the vendor at the interior gate. This includes pizza/fast food or grocery deliveries. Doing so will prevent unauthorized access to the park or confusion for vendors.

**Fishing:** Fish from the shore or piers; not in the roped off swimming area. Illinois Fishing license required for those 16+.

**Campers may not use** the FLB address for mail or packages. Consider using **My Mailbox**, **Fox Lake**.

#### Bag leaves & yard waste

### End of Season

- Fish Lake Beach is open until Sunday, October 15th, 2023. This is the last night you may stay in your trailer. At 4pm on October 16th, 2023, we lock the exterior gate near Route 12 and the exterior gate near Volo Village Rd.
- Water will be turned off the morning of Monday, October 16th, 2023.
- Overnight stays, fishing, boating, and campfires are prohibited starting Monday, October 16th, 2023.
- If you are working on your site or trailer, you MUST have those projects done before the date of closing, October 16th, 2023.
- Cleaning up your site and preparing your unit for the off-season should be completed by October 16th at 4pm. If necessary, seasonal campers may come into the park October 17th-22nd from 9am-3pm however, you MUST bring your key card to enter.
- An attendant will be at the gate on **Oct 21st and 22nd from 9a-3pm.** No keycard is required while the attendant is present.
- Beginning Monday Oct 23, admission to the park may be possible for urgent needs only. Email camping@fishlakebeach.com or call 847-546-4777 for management permission.
- Electric meters will be read after closing. You can expect your final electric bill to be emailed to you around November 1st. Payment for electric can be, paid online, called in Monday-Friday 9-3, or sent via mail.
- Reminder: All boats on the Fish Lake Beach shoreline need to be removed. Any boats left on shoreline will be considered abandoned and disposed of.
- Deposits for the 2024 season are due by October 15th 2023.
- \*New\* To be eligible for 2024 Guest Car Pass, the deposit needs to be turned in by the due date of October 15th, 2023 and then be paid in full by April 15th, 2024.

### **Additional Reminders**

- Any items that can blow around/or cause damage must be secured or stored in the unit or shed. Patio-Mate tops must be removed and stored
- Remove or store valuables such as tools, bikes, ladders, power washers, grills, fishing gear, and electronics.
- Utilities: Turn off the outside water spigot and remove water hose; store it inside the unit or shed. If you
  choose to leave your electricity plugged in, be sure to unplug anything that uses electricity. Shut off the LP
  gas.
