- We provide the straw, twine and pumpkin head.... You provide the chair for the scarecrow to sit on, scissors to cut the twine and clothes for your scarecrow! Scarecrow must be made and displayed in good taste.
- Pumpkin for head can be picked up earlier Saturday to be decorated with markers or carved.
- Scare crow will be built to sit on chair with pumpkin for the head resting on body.
- Scarecrows will be judged on creativity and originality. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places

Camper Rules and Policies at Fish Lake Beach

Overnight, Rental and Monthly Campers MUST comply with the rules signed at check in. A copy can be obtained at the store.

Seasonal Campers MUST comply with the rules in the 2024 Handbook Additional copies can be obtained at the store. Golf Cart Permit owners must comply with those rules or risk losing their permit. Do not allow anyone without a drivers license drive the cart!! Drive slowly, watch for others.

Trash Talk

If the dumpster nearest to you is full, please use another dumpster. Do not leave large items IN or AT dumpsters. Large items must be paid for in the store. We will pick up the items at your site and take them to a special dumpster.

IMPORTANT Tank & Toilet Talk

Paper towels, feminine hygiene products, and wipes, **including those marked as "flushable wipes"** cannot be put in toilets. They don't disintegrate, get tangled in our pumps, and cause sewage to overflow **on the ground and possibly inside the trailer. Please dispose of these in your bathroom waste basket.**

Parking

Campers and guests must park within the parking area of their site. If your vehicle(s) take up more than your parking area allows, those vehicles must be parked in the circle drive by the fishing pier. Security monitors parking.

Gate Info

The interior entry gate opens with access cards. No card is needed to exit. Both gates are programmed to allow one car to enter or exit at a time. Damage to gate equipment is subject to a \$700 fine. The gatehouse area is video monitored 24x7.

2025 Seasonal Information

2025 Seasonal Deposit of \$500 is due on Sept 15th, 2024. **Payment in full** is required by **April 15th, 2025.**

Individual invoices for the 2025 season have been emailed to the emails on file. Other things to keep in mind:

- If your deposit isn't received by Sept 15th, 2024, you risk losing your seasonal site.
- If **you change your mind and will not be renewing** your site license for the 2025 season and want your deposit refunded, you must inform us in writing by **January 15th, 2025**, in order for your deposit to be refunded.
- If you do not pay your deposit by September 15, 2024, you will not be eligible for guest passes in 2025, even if your balance is paid in full by April 15th, 2025.

For Your Information

Guest Admission for Overnight, Monthly and Rental Campers: Admission, \$6 per person (\$10 per person on holiday weekends). Guests must leave by 10p.

Guests of Seasonal Campers: Admission, \$6 per person. Guests must leave by 10p

All Guest must park at the lake parking area if there are already 2 cars at your site or your site cannot accommodate your guests' vehicles.

Deliveries: Campers that order goods or services must meet the vendor at the interior gate.

Fishing: Fish from the shore or piers; not in the roped off swimming area. Illinois Fishing license required for those 16+. Catch and Release until June 15th.

Campers may not use the FLB address for mail or packages. Consider using **Mail Drop Shoppe, Fox Lake.**

Bag leaves & yard waste

Grounds Staff collects BAGGED LEAVES & YARD WASTE at the curb of seasonal sites on Monday/ Friday. Put yard waste bags at your curb the **night before pick-up days**. Do not put yard waste bags in or at dumpsters. Please use paper yard waste bags.

Scooters, Electric Bikes, and Non-Electric Bikes

New Campground POLICY-Starting 7/18/24 electric scooters and electric bikes may NOT be used in the campground **by anyone under 16 years of age**. This new policy was created in response to a growing pattern of fast and reckless riding behavior by kids and adults. Adults and riders 16 years old and over must comply with posted speed limits and stop at all signs and intersections before proceeding. While this new policy applies to electric bikes and scooters, the same rules apply to non-motorized bicycle use. Please wear a helmet. Thank You.
